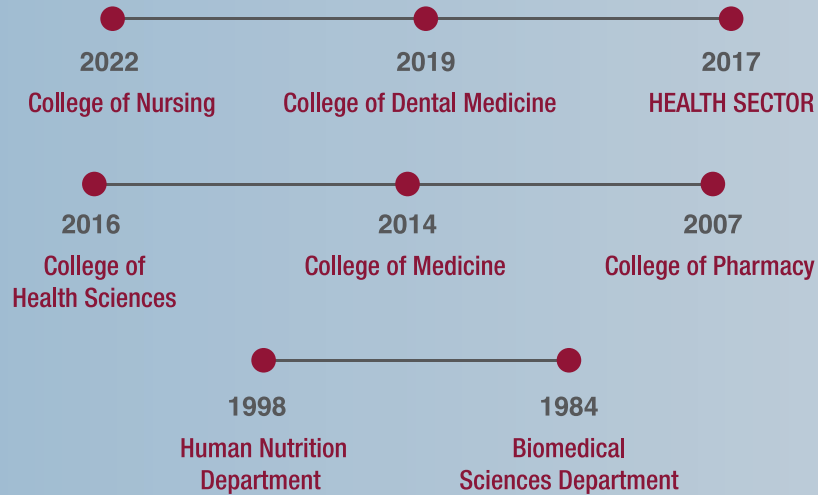

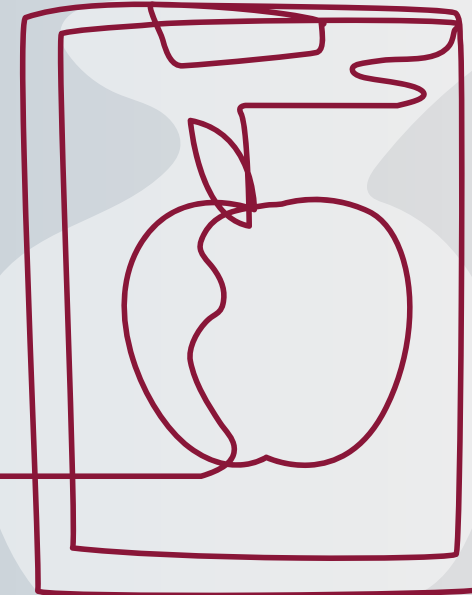

Why Study Nutrition & Dietetics at Qatar University?

1

The program is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND), USA since 2017.

2

Graduates are eligible to apply for licensure as a Dietitian in Qatar with the Ministry of Public Health.

3

Graduates of the program are eligible to apply for a dietetic internship in the United States to become Registered Dietitians (RD).

The program enables students to complete their postgraduate studies in health-related fields.

The Department of Nutrition Sciences offers a comprehensive range of programs, including the BSc in Nutrition & Dietetics with one year of supervised clinical practice, an MSc in Nutrition, a Minor in Food Safety, and a Minor in Nutrition.
