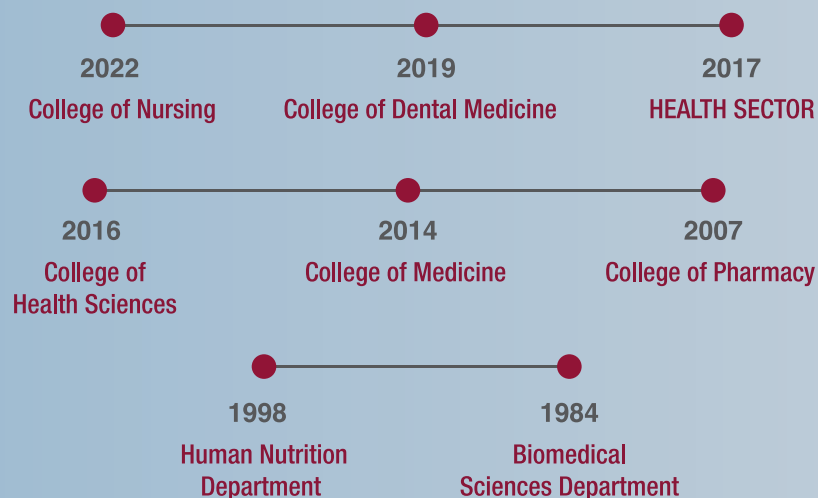

Why Study Public Health at Qatar University?

- 1 The program is the first of its kind in Qatar, multidisciplinary in nature, preparing students in health, environment, and population sciences to prevent disease, save lives, and promote health from a population perspective.
