Dr. Ali is an Assistant Professor in Pharmacy Practice at The University of Manchester, with extensive experience in both quantitative and qualitative research. He was the first pharmacist researcher to receive the prestigious NIHR SPCR Post-Doctoral Fellowship. Together with Dr. Hala Shokr, an experienced Assistant Professor in Cardiovascular Research at The University of Manchester, Ali co-founded the Applied Cardiovascular Research Centre (ACRC). They are currently leading national research workstreams in collaboration with prominent healthcare research organizations across the UK. The ACRC team comprises medical specialists, WHO consultants, and policymakers, all working together to drive impactful cardiovascular research.
