◆ **Meeting Agenda:**

◆ **Topics that discussed during the Meeting:**

1. **The meeting opened with a discussion of the "Hayakum" (Discover Your University) event, which is the most important event for first-year students in particular, but a decline in the number of students attending from the College of Engineering and health colleges was observed due to the fact that the "First-Year Seminar" course, whose professors motivate their request to attend, is not a requirement in these colleges.**
2. **The "Hayakum" event was discussed for admitted students during the spring semester with the aim of introducing them to the university and its various services.**
  - » **Dr. Majed Fathalla** presented the idea of organizing introductory tours around the various university buildings led by a student representative, during which the services provided by the student affairs sector are introduced, in order to enhance the visibility and promotion of the role of student leadership.
  - » Participating students will also visit the activities and receive a stamp from each booth visited, and at the end of the event, the best participating leader will be honored.
3. **Presentation of the Qatar University Gift Shop project, which will carry goods that beautify the university's identity, with the aim of enhancing the sense of belonging among students who survived the university, and opening the door for the proposals of the Student Representative Board in this regard:**
  - » Member **Mohammed Al-Sayed** proposed to provide a sticker printing service to benefit student clubs and student representative boards.
  - » Member **Mohammad Al Emadi** proposed to provide a special product in collaboration with a Qatari brand such as Al Bidda. The member suggested that the gifts should bear youth phrases for each student club or organization, and suggested the provision of iron or magnetic shields and stickers, as well as the provision of a perfume product for Qatar University. The member also suggested

that the store support the alumni business by showcasing their work and collaborating with a charitable organization to donate the store's profits.

- » Member **Abdulaziz Al-Agey** proposed to provide a hard disk product.
- » **Dr. Majed Fathalla** suggested that there should be a corner of the store for graduation ceremonies.

4. **Ms. Israa Al-Balasi presented the project of fixed phone charging stations at the university:**

- » Member **Abdulaziz Al-Qahtani** suggested that power banks be provided instead of charging stations, as they are practical and allow students to charge their phones during their lectures without leaving them out of sight.
- » Member **Mohamed Hashim Al-Sayed** suggested that power banks should be rechargeable at the university only to prevent losing them.
- » It was proposed that the process of borrowing chargers should be similar to the process of borrowing books and printing, and a fine will be imposed on the student's account in case the mobile charger is not returned after borrowing it.
- » Member **Abdulaziz Al-Qahtani** suggested that students be allowed to borrow the power bank from one building and return it in another building to facilitate the student's movement during the day.

5. **The members of the Student Representative Council were asked about some general proposals, which were as follows:**

- » A member of the Student Representative Board shared the idea of providing scooters for students to travel between university buildings, but it was rejected due to the risk of accidents.
- » Member **Mohammed Hashim Al-Sayed** suggested providing a lounge for students to spend their time during their breaks.
- » Member **Maryam Al-Mohannadi** proposed the idea of having a nurse's room in each building, as a nurse's presence is more practical than going to the university's health center.
- » Member **Mohammed Hashim Al-Sayed** suggested that vending machines accept bank cards as a payment method.
- » Member **Abdulaziz Al-Agey** suggested providing rest halls for drivers and maids to wait for students instead of waiting for them outside.
- » Member **Mohammad Al-Emadi** suggested opening cafes that are popular among students, but Ms. **Israa Al-Balasi** explained that the opening of food outlets is through tenders and auctions, and the food outlet with the best and most suitable offer for the university is chosen..
