◆ **Meeting Agenda:**

◆ **Topics that discussed during the Meeting:**

1. Members of Mishkat Quran Club presented the idea for an initiative centered around organizing Quranic sessions, which will be spread across different stations in each college. The sessions will take place from February 2, 2025, to May 8, 2025. The initiative includes the following:
 - » This collaboration will involve Mishkat Quran Club, The Prayer Club, The Ministry of Endowments and Islamic Affairs, and the Student Representative Board.
 - » Mishkat Quran Club will collaborate with the Ministry of Endowments and Islamic Affairs to provide 5 teachers, while the Prayer Club will provide 15 teachers.
 - » Each teacher from the Ministry of Endowments and Islamic Affairs will supervise 4 sessions, with 5 to 8 students in each session. As for the Prayer Club teachers, each will supervise one session with 5 students.
 - » The total number of beneficiaries from these sessions will be 200 female students.
 - » The sessions will be promoted by Member Bayan Fawzi, with an emphasis on advertising and using QU Announcement to reach all students. Additionally, the booking of rooms for the sessions in each college will be arranged.
 - » The Student Representative Board Specialist emphasized the need to inform Mr. Yasser Al-Qawasmi about this initiative and get his approval to ensure the proper collaboration.
 - » Member Adeb Alshubrumi expressed the need to know the number of students per session to reserve rooms based on required capacity, as they are currently facing challenges in room bookings, and this information would expedite the process.
2. Member Ameera Al-Dosari clarified that the Administrative Body is currently tallying the number of graduating members of the Student Representative Board, as they will graduate before the end of the cycle, which could prevent them from receiving certificates for their

participation during the two semesters. By identifying graduates early, it provides enough time to work on getting an exemption for them, acknowledging their active role. Members Abdulrahman Al-Sayed, Adeb Alshubrumi, and Manar Al-Yafei confirmed that they will graduate in the Spring 2025 semester.

- » Member Nour Al-Din Jabara asked whether the graduate list includes all members or only the heads of the boards. Member Abdulrahman Al-Sayed responded that the list includes all members of the Student Representative Board.

3. Member Abdulrahman Al-Sayed outlined the Student Representative Board's participation in Spring 2025, which includes the following:

- » The Student Representative Board will participate in the Annual Research Forum and Exhibition, with its own booth, in addition to showcasing research from outstanding undergraduate students from various colleges wishing to display their students' work.
- » Member Adeb Alshubrumi inquired about the number of research papers required to be displayed at the board's booth. Member Abdulrahman Al-Sayed clarified that one research paper would suffice. Member Omar Al-Sayed added that many medical research papers are collaborative, and asked if they would follow the same selection process. Member Abdulrahman confirmed that they would, whether it's research or a project.
- » The Student Representative Board will participate in the Qatar University Graduates Reunion Ceremony, providing two tents, one for females and one for males. The event will also invite all former board presidents and outstanding alumni, giving current members an opportunity to meet and learn from their experiences. The board will open a call for volunteers to help with the event.
- » Member Adeb Alshubrumi mentioned that the College of Arts and Sciences Student Representative Board will mainly collaborate with the college, but they will strive to distribute tasks to support both the board and the college.

4. Member Abdulrahman Al-Sayed mentioned that the Student Representative Board is currently working on amending its constitution to better align with the new vision and mission of the university.

5. Member Mohamed Al-Sayed shared updates from his meeting with the organizing committee for the Cultural Village event, where he emphasized the need to contact one member from each board to act as promoters for the event by posting or speaking about it with their peers or contacting someone in their college. He added that the event's venue has not yet been determined.

6. Member Abdulrahman Al-Sayed requested that the Administrative Body be provided with a list of events each board plans to hold in the Spring 2025 semester to ensure necessary support, such as media coverage or student recruitment, to promote participation and the success of these events.

7. Member Ibrahim Al-Arabi discussed the issue of the board's inability to resolve some student issues and how to deal with this challenge.

Member Abdulrahman Al-Sayed emphasized the importance of recognizing the board's role as a liaison, noting that it is not necessary to solve all problems but to communicate them to the relevant administrative bodies. He also reiterated the approach established in previous meetings, where unresolved issues from the college boards are raised to the General Assembly and the Administrative Body to contribute to finding solutions.
8. Member Ibrahim Al-Arabi raised a concern about the scheduling of meetings not being suitable for students in the College of Medicine, particularly since he had to request permission from the department head to attend, which posed some difficulty. Member Abdulrahman Al-Sayed responded that the scheduling was varied to accommodate all Student Representative Board members, appreciating their commitment despite their busy schedules.

◆ **Meeting Report:**

1. Mishkat Quran Club will send an email to the members of the Student Representative Board to begin cooperation and book rooms for the Quranic sessions, after receiving approval from Mr. Yasser Al-Qawasmi.
2. An email will be sent to all Student Representative Boards to attach the names of the graduates, in preparation for obtaining the necessary approvals to issue certificates that document their efforts and active role in the board.
3. Some student issues, which have not been resolved, will be raised by the College of Medicine Board to the Administrative Body for review.
